

RADIOLOGY STUDY PROGRAMME STUDENTS' SURVEY ABOUT THE CONTENT OF THE SUBJECT AND TEACHING QUALITY

AUTUMN SEMESTER 2025-2026

DURATION: The study subjects of the Radiology study programme taken in the autumn semester of 2025-2026 could be assessed until 27 February 2026.

OBJECTIVE: To reveal the opinion of students of the Radiology study programme about the quality of content and teaching of the study subjects.

TARGET GROUP: Students of the Radiology study programme who have attended the study subjects of the Radiology study programme in the autumn semester of 2025-2026 and received evaluations.

OBJECT OF THE RESEARCH: quality of the content and teaching of the study subjects of the Radiology study programme carried out in the autumn semester of 2025–2026.

RESEARCH METHOD – data collection, data collection tool – questionnaire (quantitative and qualitative empirical data collected). The survey was conducted in the electronic space, in the Study Management System. The data was processed using Microsoft Excel. Students' participation in the survey is voluntary, the survey is anonymous. The students evaluated the quality of the content and teaching according to pre-formulated statements on a five-point scale (1 – I strongly disagree, 5 – I completely agree). Students of the Radiology study programme had to assess the quality of the subject content according to 6 criteria, and the quality of teaching according to 8 criteria.

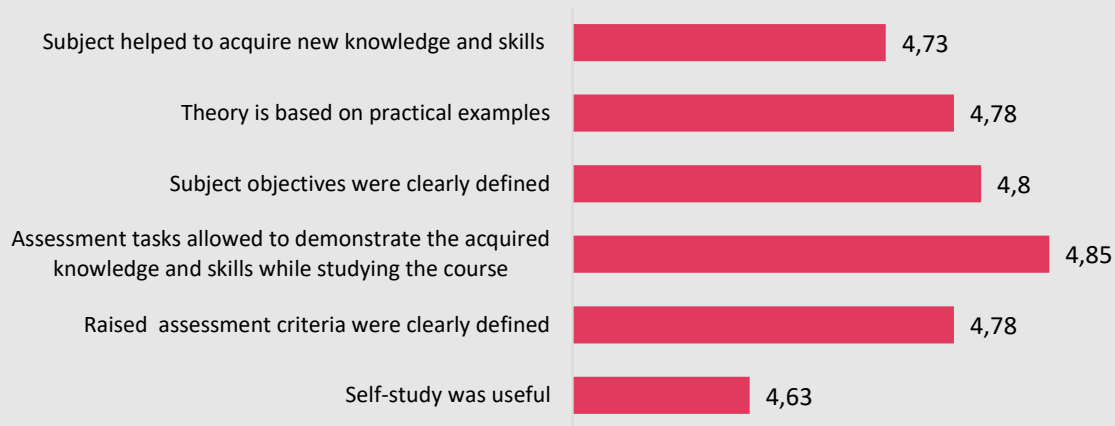


Figure 1. Assessment of the content quality of the subjects of "Radiology" study programme " according to the criteria

RESULTS: The study management system received 61 fully completed questionnaires of the Radiology study programme students. According to the research results, the quality of the content of the subjects of the Radiology study programme is rated very well by students (4.76 points out of 5). Most respondents agree with the statements that "The lecturer provided an opportunity to demonstrate the acquired abilities" – 4.85 points; "Subject objectives clearly defined" – 4.80 points; "Theory based on examples" – 4.78 points; "Clear/understandable criteria" – 4.78 points. Slightly fewer respondents agreed with the statement "Self-study was useful" – 4.63 points (see Figure 1).

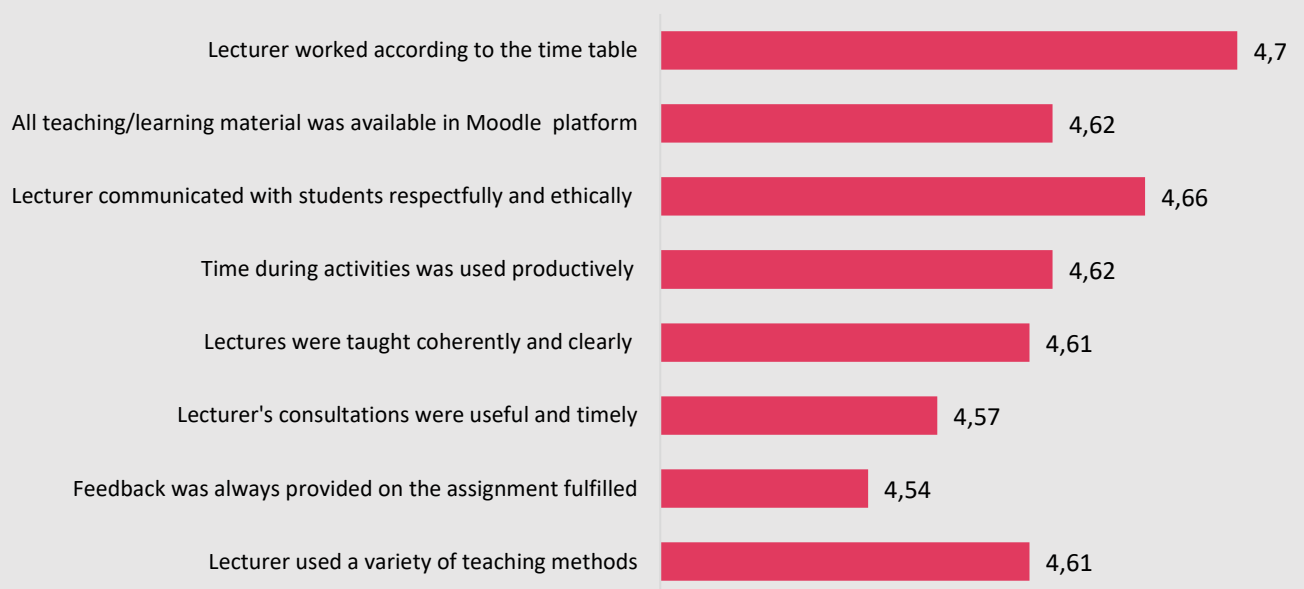


Figure 2. Assessment of teaching quality of the subjects of "Radiology" study programme according to the criteria

In the opinion of the students of the Radiology study programme who participated in the survey, the quality of teaching of the subjects of the Radiology study programme was evaluated very well (4.67 points out of 5). Students mostly agreed with the statements: "The lecturer worked according to the schedule" – 4.70 points; "The lecturer communicated with the students respectfully and ethically – 4.66 points; "Methodological material is available in Moodle" – 4.62 points. Slightly less respondents agree with the statements: "The lecturer's consultations were useful and timely" – 4.57 points; "Feedback provided" – 4.54 points (see Figure 2).
