

Reference period:

From September 2025 to February 2026

Aim:

To analyze students' opinions on elective study modules and the quality of their teaching.

Questionnaire:

The quality of elective study modules was evaluated based on 14 criteria. Students expressed their opinions using a five-point rating scale: *Strongly Agree*; *Agree*; *Neither Agree nor Disagree*; *Disagree*; *Strongly Disagree*.

Elective modules were positively evaluated during the autumn semester of 2025–2026. This is confirmed by 61% of the students who participated in the survey.
